POINT DUME sprinted to the early lead, was kept in the two path controlling the pace around the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and drew off under vigorous rousing. BLUE KINGDOM , never far back, remained along the inner rail throughout and rallied. QUINT'S BREW , forwardly placed in the two path between horses leaving the backstretch and around the turn, chased the winner to upper stretch then gradually weakened in the drive. SLAM NOTION stalked the pace outside horses down the backstretch, advanced four deep on the turn, was well positioned turning for home and gave way. PETINGAS TWIN , rated behind horses leaving the backstretch and entering the turn, angled four wide approaching the stretch and came up empty. FREEZE THE FIRE chased the winner from the three path for a half mile and weakened in upper stretch. ON THE MARK , pinched back soon after the break, angled five wide approaching the stretch and was not a factor.
