SUN SUMMERS secured the pocket after the field had been released, kept watch within striking distance, turned into the lane, obtained clear room along the rail corridor soon afterwards, forged to the front, felt some heavy pressure in the final stages, but dug in with good determination to prevail. GOGO SHOES saved ground for the opening three-quarters, angled four wide for the drive home, finished with willingness down the center of the course to garner the place. WINDFALL PROFIT tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, slowly made her way into the two path as three-quarters was being reeled off, idled along in traffic, out-shouldered a weakening SHORT POUR just past the eighth pole to secure running room, mustered up a mild response for the show. APURATE circled its way into the role of primary pursuer with a three wide run on the clubhouse bend, tucked closer to the rail stepping onto the backstretch and went on to press the issue from there all the way to the quarter pole, moved a bit wider to challenge about three wide stepping onto the top of the lane, flattened out. FIERCE SCARLETT chased the pace two wide for nearly six furlongs, tipped into path three coming up to the five-sixteenths pole, finished off the run around the far turn, got steered out towards path six from upper to midstretch, narrowed in. UNA LUNA mostly two wide early,

travelled in path three on the second bend, was one path wider getting ridden into the lane, lacked the necessary response. R V TREASURE brought up the back of the pack, tucked along the rail at the half mile pole, continued along it, angled three wide coming into the lane, had no rally. EYE OF A SOLDIER quickly placed in path two, ventured on it for three-quarters, arrived in the stretch, got sent out seven wide but all to no avail. FIONNBHARR two wide on both turns, was slightly wider on the backstretch, went into path six for the drive home, came up empty. SHORT POUR broke on top and retained the advantage, showed the way from the rail, shadowed by APURATE from the outside, got overhauled in the furlong grounds, steadily backed away.
