DIRECT ORDER chased just off the inside from just off the pace, tucked inside half a mile from home, came under coaxing near the quarter pole, angled five to six wide into upper stretch, rallied to take command near the eighth pole, inched away kept to task to the finish. BUSINESS CYCLE chased four then three wide from just off the pace, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths and advanced to take command swinging four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was collared near the eighth pole, ran on to preserve the place honors by a nostril on the wire. AUTOSTRADE chased three wide from mid pack, tucked inside at the half mile pole, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch and offered up a mild kick. MILLS chased three to four wide under a ride from the three-eighths, angled six wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid, then kept on to the finish for the last major share. FINANCIAL FREEDOM dueled four then three wide with REAL DAN to his inside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide for home and weakened. ORPHEUS (ARG) five then four wide in pursuit, came under coaxing two to three wide at the three-eighths, went six wide into upper stretch and offered no response. REAL DAN hustled from the gate, dueled two to three wide with FINANCIAL FREEDOM to his outside, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, spun three wide for home and weakened. SUMMER BOURBON chased five to six wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, went seven wide into upper stretch and weakened. EDEN RIDGE chased just off the inside under a ride from the seven-sixteenths, swung three to four wide

for home and made no impact. NEIGHBORHOOD BULLY chased five paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three to four wide through the turn, went four to five wide for home and trailed.
