KEY BISCAZYNE at a considerable distance from off the rail throughout, argued as the outermost of a trio from path four for a good portion of the opening three-quarters, shifted inward to go at it one on with PANDAMOM afterwards, was switched over to a drive in the general area of the five-sixteenths marker, turned into the lane, drew off. WICKED AMBER departed the backstretch four wide, pursued the pace being hand urged on the turn, was moved one path closer to the rail after coming into the lane, rallied mildly to procure the place. PANDAMOM remained stationed in the two path after the start, was forced to contend inside a pair of opponents for the top for almost six furlongs, was out-fought by the winner late on the bend, got roused angling five wide into the stretch, backed away. PURE RHYTHM took the inside route until the conclusion of the backstretch, tipped towards path two at the top of the turn, was still there entering the stretch, never made her presence felt. UNA LUNA in path three, was the middle member of a threesome vying for the lead for the opening three-quarters, wandered six to seven wide into the lane in retreat.
