AMANI'S KITTEN raced off a good pace, wore down the leaders in the stretch and edged up between horses for the win late. UNCLE EARL chased a good pace from the second flight inside, came into the stretch in the four path and made a steady advance for second. DRAGON DREW chased and pressured the pacesetter, led at the sixteenth pole and yielded in deep stretch. DERBY CITY was off the pace, took the turn five wide and chased the leaders down the lane. FORBETTERORWORSE showed speed inside, lost the lead in upper stretch and faltered late. TOM'S LAST GENERAL needed more on the turn and angled widest in the stretch. HORSEFEATHERS broke slowly and never threatened.
