GOT YOUR NUMBER angled toward the inside to set a pressured pace off the rail, moved clear into the turn and dug in under steady encouragement to hold on well. SPLIT THE CHECK chased the pace and raced near the rail on the turn turn settled for second best. MY PRETTY EYES gave chase through the backstretch, raced in the five path on the turn and finished evenly. CHOPRA gave chase and raced at the rail on the turn then finished evenly. LA RUFINA chased the pace, raced in the five path of the turn and finished evenly. STROLLING THROUGH chased the pace, raced in the six path of the turn and finished evenly. TRUENO FUERTE was not a factor. OBSCENE pressured the early pace inside but steadied at the rail approaching the quarter pole, eased slightly out from that point but steadily faded. WOODSONG'S CASTLE hesitated at the break, raced wide early and was not a factor.
