HYDRA set a pressured pace along the rail, was headed nearing the lane, vied inside through the stretch and dug in to prevail. VICS COOL CAT stalked the pace inside, angled three wide near the quarter pole, bid outside in midstretch, dueled through the final furlong but was turned back. GRAY HAZE broke a bit slowly, was rank early, pulled her way toward the front down the backstretch, vied two wide around the turn, had the lead turning for home, dueled between rivals through the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in deep stretch and was outfinished. WORSTBESTIDEAEVER lagged well back outside and rallied belatedly. HAD THE NOTION angled to the rail near the three-eighths pole and lacked a closing bid. EMBRACE A NEW DAY failed to menace while racing two wide. BE BOP A LOLA chased the pace three wide and came up empty in the lane.
