DAH PHILLY stalked the pace inside, waited patiently behind a wall of horses around the far turn, angled four wide nearing the quarter pole, closed determinedly outside and was up in deep stretch. LUNA settled off the pace while racing four wide, circled four wide around the far turn, took the lead and burst clear nearing the quarter pole, finished willingly but was unable to stave off the winner in the final yards. RUBY PUNCH set a pressured pace in the two path, could not keep pace with the top two leaving the quarter pole but stayed on to save the show. FRENCH NOUGET had early speed between rivals and faded. CHA CHA HEELS failed to menace while racing two wide early and four wide around the far turn. DON'T FIGHT pressed the pace four wide around the first turn, bid three wide between rivals around the far turn and retreated rapidly nearing the lane. OLA GATITA had brief speed five wide.
