Footnotes

TONS OF GOLD went along covered up behind the leaders to the far turn, shifted out to the four-path to challenge leaving the quarter-pole, wrested command through mid stretch and drove clear. CAN'T HAVE ENOUGH moved in from the four-path early on the first turn, came back out three wide for the drive, and finished gamely outside SHARETHEBLAME to get the place. SHARETHEBLAME broke slowly, cut the corner making a run into the stretch, loomed a threat along the rail a furlong out, but was outfinished. DIAMONDS ENJOY sprinted clear early a bit off the rail, repelled a bid from WICKED CITI coming to the quarter-pole, then gave way between horses in upper stretch. NEW YORK STYLE raced three to four wide throughout, and faded in the lane. WICKED CITI prompted the pace outside DIAMONDS ENJOY, reached near-even terms after six furlongs, but had nothing left into the stretch.
