SIERRA HOTEL sprinted clear of the field along the rail racing to the backstretch, held sway on a clear margin past midstretch and just held the late challenge of ALWAYS COOL under firm encouragement. The latter was rated inside foes just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out in upper stretch and continued willingly between foes to close the gap on the winner to the end. BIG MAN BOB, reserved off the second flight outside foes racing to the backstretch, angled to the rail nearing upper stretch and continued with a steady effort inside the top pair to gain position to the end. HIGH HEATER, forwardly placed tracking the pacesetter from out of striking distance near the inside racing to the backstretch, was prompted to advance on the leader racing into the far turn, drifted out racing through the stretch and faded in late stages. TORNADO BOY tracked the pacesetter between rivals in second flight racing to the far turn and continued evenly into the stretch. GOOD INTENT, reserved last in early stages, swung six wide racing into the lane to gain some position but made no real impression. LOST IN MANHATTAN settled inside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch and never mounted a serious challenge. ROAR OF THE LION, held up avoiding close quarters at the start, settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and failed to mount a serious challenge. DONIVAN MY BOY was rated off the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the backstretch but faded early. OVERPRAISE tracked the pacesetter three wide as part of the second flight racing to the backstretch and gave way on the far turn.
