FRA MAURO was well placed early on, raced along the inside into the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. PROMPT was back early on, rallied along the far turn, made a bid in the stretch but weakened late in the drive. ACHIKULAK vied for the lead early, angled off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch. COURAGE AND HONOR chased the pace early, took over command, led the field into the lane and gave way late in the drive. SOMEBODY'S BEAU was never a thredat. TAPIT CITY set the pace for a half then folded ip. KING'S PAWN was through after three quarters. HIGH BEAM was through after a half. DIXIELAND RAGS was done early. MEANWHILE had early speed then folded up. RACE ONLY HAS A FINAL TIME LISTED BY PHOTO FINISH.
