PERFECT KIND came out at the start, set the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane, inched clear in the stretch but yielded late in the drive. VASILISA was bumped at the start, chased the pace early, was well off the rail into the lane, rallied in the stretch, was gaining late and missed place in the final stages. VORTICES stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch run. BOURBON ENDOWMENT chased the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. ARTISTIC was back early on, raced well off the rail into the lane with some gain in the stretch. LADY BLUE was never a threat. COURTESY NOTICE was never a factor. PRIMA VALENTINA was bumped at the start, tracked the pace early, raced well off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch. LAKE GIRL showed little. LADY BREXIT was through after a half. TAPATAZ was done early. ALL TIMES ARE HAND-TIMED EXCEPT THE FINAL TIME.

UBER KIRK stalked the pace early, was well off the rail into the lane, was under a long drive in the stretch from between horses, was bumped around and steadied in the final stages. GOTTSACKER bobbled at the start, stalked the pace early, was on the inside into the lane with some gain in the stretch run. LATROBE'S KING was back early on, raced well off the rail into the lane and moved up in the stretch drive. SQUADRON FOURTEEN was bumped at the start, raced well off the rail into the lane and faded late in the stretch. VICTORY CIGAR tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and was empty late in the stretch drive. EXTIRPATOR was never a threat. ASPEN SNOW ran off in the post-parade. EL CAPA ROJO was through after a half. COMMISSIONER BOLT was never involved. WOLF was bumped and squeezed at the start. THE RIDER OF UBER KIRK CLAIMED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDERS OF TAXMAN AND FOOCH FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH RUN BUT WAS DISALLOWED AFTER REVIEW BY THE STEWARDS.
