BIG OL FIRE chased the pace early, was well off the rail into the lane, made a bid in the stretch and was gaining in the late stages. BIZZEE CHANNEL set pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and yielded late in the drive. ARANSAS was back early on, was well off the rail into the lane with a late gain in the stretch run. ROTATION stalked the pace early, was on the inside into the lane and flattened out late in the stretch drive. FLUELLEN was back early on, angled off the rail into the lane with a belated gain in the stretch run. UNITY was never a threat. MAJESTIC HERO tracked the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and weakened late. GIANT K was through after a half. TIN SOLDIER was never a threat. MR AMBROSE broke slowly and was no factor. TOHUBOHU bucked at the start then lost the irons for a short time and was outrun. ALL TIMES ARE HAND-TIMED EXCEPT THE FINAL TIME.

COUNTRY CHICK tracked four wide, ranged up to engage the leaders nearing the furlong marker, quickly shook clear and maintained a safe advantage. FOCUSED broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride, wheeled out entering the stretch, kicked on well and was making up ground, but was left with too much to do. TRACE was unhurried early, settled at the tail of the field, weaved through traffic through the stretch, and finished well for the show. GIRL'S NIGHT prompted the pace too deep, contested the issue to inside the furlong marker and gave in. LIFEFULLOFREINBOWS steadied from tight quarters down the hill, settled off of the inside, came five wide and improved position between rivals. OUR GRAYCIOUS GIRL settled saving ground, shifted out leaving the turn and finished with a mild gain. SILLA MANILA was allowed to settle, angled out into the stretch and made a belated improvement. ULTIMA D was allowed to settle three wide, came five wide, moved up to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. POCKET BOOK vied for the lead along the inside to the final furlong and faltered. THE GIRL FACTOR contended between horses to the eighth pole and tired. HIDDEN JADE was forwardly placed along the inside to the eighth pole and retreated. TUMULTUOUS GAL saved ground to no avail. ALL TIMES ARE HAND-TIMED EXCEPT THE FINAL TIME.

BUSHROD settled off of the inside within striking distance, tipped out leaving the turn to commence his bid, caught BELGIAN a sixteenth out and proved narrowly best. BELGIAN attended the pace to the outside of his stablemate, took over inside the quarter pole, dug in to meet the challenge but grudgingly gave in.
