BUCKEY'S CHARM rallied outside on the turn, closed willingly and wore down her rivals to get up late. MISCHIEFS MODEL broke slowly, challenged for the lead on the turn, inched clear, led to deep stretch and was outclosed in a good effort. SPEED LANE pressed the pace while racing along the rail, lacked room mid stretch, went willingly to the wire and got up for show. TARGE raced between horses near the inside and lacked the needed late response. MIT MAZEL was void of early speed, swung wide entering the stretch and offered a mild bid only. NO DOWN DAYS set a pressured pace to the turn, weakened and faded from contention. KEEPYOURSKATESON showed speed to the turn and tired. GREAT CAUSE was outrun.
