INDIAN GULCH broke through the gate prior without getting loose, then vied inside for the lead, dueled on the backside and far turn, raced well off the rail entering the stretch, battled back gamely past the furlong marker and prevailed. EKATI WILDCAT vied outside for the lead, dueled with INDIAN GULCH on the far turn, came wide into the stretch, gained a short lead, dug in gamely outside in the final furlong and was outfinished. GYPSUM JOHNNY raced off the pace inside, two wide on the far turn and rallied mildly on the rail. PAINTER'S PRIDE raced off the pace, came three wide into the lane and had no rally. PURIMETER raced four wide on the first turn, then stalked outside, raced inside on the far turn and tired. DEDICATED raced three wide on the first turn, vied three wide on the backside, then chased and faded.
