FAMISHED tracked close up on the inside, bid two wide entering the far turn, dueled briefly, responded when roused, took over in upper stretch and drew clear under urging. KING KOA set the pace on the inside, dueled with the winner on the far turn, dug in gamely in the stretch drive and remained clear for the place spot. FLATTER ME raced off the pace, moved up four wide on the far turn, rallied outside turning for home, bid and flattened out. TROUVER raced four wide early, then stalked three wide, chased three wide on the far turn and weakened. DANGERFIELD raced off the pace inside, saved ground on the far turn, made a mild bid at the quarter pole, then weakened. UMBRAGE raced three wide early, then stalked two wide, chased inside on the far turn and faded. EVEN THUNDER pressed the pace in the early stages, then chased two wide and gave way.
