### Footnotes

SUNFLOWER GIRL was bumped at the start, vied between rivals for the lead, edged away, drew clear in upper stretch and held well under urging. AWESOMENEWEYEAR chased inside, came four wide into the lane, rallied, finished well but second best. CHARGING RENEE raced off the pace inside, rallied mildly inside and was along for the show spot. TUMBADORA was bumped at the start, vied inside for the lead, then chased and weakened. DIVA DANA stalked outside, was forced wide to avoid an injured rival at the quarter pole and weakened. MISS MARGARET ANN vied three wide for the lead, chased on the turn and tired. CINNAMON LATTE chased outside, was injured and pulled up at the quarter pole, vanned off. After a Stewards' Inquiry, the race was declared official.
