GANGLY chased the pacesetter, was urged far to challenge on the far turn, rallied three wide in the stretch and prevailed under a stiff drive. STYNER sped clear, had his advantage dwindle on the far turn, dug in when challenged inside of the eighth pole and kept on stubbornly. SKIMBLE SHANKS leaned in at the start, was bothered early, outrun while three wide, angled in entering the stretch and rallied for a minor share. ROB THE RICH settled well, edged closer on the far turn, went four wide into the stretch and came up empty in the final furlong. HERE'S WALDO saved ground, was swung five into the stretch and managed a mild rally. AQUITANIA ARRIVAL ducked out at the start, climbed in the early stages while resenting the kick back, remained five wide for most of the way, was always outrun, eased across the wire and walked off.
