SULLEYS BOO was slow early, rallied the rail around the turn, swung out entering the stretch, took over from between rivals leaving the furlong grounds and held. LIL SURVIVOR was bumped leaving the gate, settled, rallied three wide around the turn, swung wide into the stretch, tried outside the winner through the lane but wasn't enough. BRAZILIAN BAY was hard ridden from the gate, bore out early on the backstretch, stayed inside around the turn, moved closer in early stretch then weakened. TIZ TAS TIME took command at once, drew out to a long lead in the two path on the turn then faded from between rivals in the drive. JEANNE'S JOY made a run two wide between rivals into the stretch then flattened out. LOVELY O'PRADO ducked out into LIL SURVIVOR leaving the gate, checked sharply early on the backstretch when BRAZILIAN BAY bore out, couldn't catch up and was eased up. CHIMERA moved to press outside the early leader on the backstretch, stopped after three furlongs and was eased up through the lane.
