Footnotes

NEW FOUND TREASURE settled inside, began a run into the far turn, came out between rivals entering the stretch, angled out sharply soon after, closed between rivals and was up in time. NEVISIAN SPIRIT moved to vie three wide on the final turn, dueled through the lane, led late but gave way. ARTIFFUL MOVE chased the early leader, moved two wide to vie outside that one into the far turn, dueled between rivals through the lane and faltered late. SECRET OR NOT settled two wide between rivals, edged out on the final turn, swung wide into the stretch and finished willingly outside. TEX MEE A KISS was slow early, saved ground into the stretch, came out between rivals in early stretch, angled back to the rail for room in midstretch and gained too late. MISS FORESTER stayed inside and gained too late. L. A. HOUSE moved to a clear lead from the outside before going a quarter, angled to the rail on the backstretch and faded through the final quarter. CHECK SIX had early position three wide then tired. SOBEIT SYLVIA was outrun after a slow break.
