MANAHAWKIN was slow early, circled into the stretch, finished fast outside and was along in time. CAMGO moved three wide to command before a half, was put to intermittent whip once well clear in the final furlong but was caught. CHEESE ON broke sharply, raced along the rail while with the pace into the turn, fell back and continued evenly. SKY GAZER R V F was slow early, raced wide into the stretch and lacked a closing response. IT'S THE JOURNEY was outrun after a slow break. CONQUEST PRANKSTER showed speed, moved two wide to a short lived clear lead into the turn then tired. GET A VALENTINE had early position along the rail, came out two wide on the turn then stopped. WRONG BEN was in tight between horses midway on the backstretch, came out into the three path entering the turn then stopped in the lane.
