MITHRA wide into the first turn, advanced strongly after the half and was just up for the place. AJHAR tried to bear out into the first turn, angled inside, bid and continued willingly. MARKOFTHEMAKER forced the pace outside to the three eighths pole and faltered. GRANDFIRE broke alertly and was hustled to the front inside then faded in the stretch. SPLITZVILLE raced just off the leaders then began tiring into the far turn. REBEL TRAVELLER stopped abruptly losing contact with his field.
