KING DAVID secured a forward position soon after the start, chose the three path for one to take around the second turn, bided time from there until near the quarter pole before being called upon, stayed within range of the leader during the ensuing furlong, gained ground readily thereafter, wrested away the lead in deep stretch and edged away, crossing the wire under hand encouragement. KING KREESA broke alertly, cleared the field in short order and tucked along the rail well before reaching the end of the homestretch, set dawdling factions well rated from the inside over less than ideal going while facing only the mildest of pressure, continued along under the same conditions until near the quarter pole, got released from the rating tactics being used by the pilot entering the stretch, held his ground stubbornly during the run through the furlong grounds, but with another pair lurking dangerously, was locked in battle with the winner when he came inward after some strong right handed stick work and then equally strong cross-reining, putting SUMMER FRONT in tight down along the fence and forcing the rider of that rival to steady, yielded in the final seventy yards but continued on gamely for the place. SUMMER FRONT sat reserved in the middle of the field while making his way down the backstretch, was guided over to the inside at the end of it and saved ground thereafter until very deep stretch, unleashed a menacingly rail run after turning for home to loom boldly with an eighth remaining, was still prominently placed when forced to steady off an errant foe's heels in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole, losing valuable ground and momentum as a result, found the time and put in the effort to alter course afterwards and flashed some interest after completing the maneuver. COGITO raced along the outside, was under a drive spinning into the lane, failed to threaten after mustering up a mild response. DULLAHAN contently took the inside route, under a good hold from the rider for over three-quarters, was put to encouragement commencing to angle outward approaching the quarter pole, made minimal progress on the front runners from upper to midstretch, altered course slightly more to the outside, paused for a stride with COGNITO directly up ahead a short distance, showed some very belated foot en route for minor spoils. SHKSPEARE SHALIYAH loped along at the back of the pack while kept off the rail, was let out a notch up and momentarily perked up during the later stages of the run around the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and fizzled out. HOWE GREAT rated stalking the pacesetter from the two path, failed to fire when called upon for the stretch drive.
